Yuchengco reflecting his many years as a businessman, diplomat, collector, philanthropist, patron of the arts, and advocate for education in the Philippines.</p> <p>The museum's goal is to foster a greater public appreciation of the finest in Filipino and Filipino-Chinese visual expression and build cultural bridges to the Asia-Pacific community by providing a venue for visiting and exchange exhibitions. Location	The museum is located at the heart of RCBC (Rizal Commercial Banking Corporation) Plaza, which is the biggest and most modern office development in the Philippines today. The complex consists of two towers—the Yuchengco Tower and Tower 2. Aside from the Yuchengco Museum, the complex includes an open courtyard, a 150-seat chapel, convenience stores, a food court, a gym and health spa, and the 450-seat Carlos P. Romulo auditorium. RCBC Plaza stands on an island site bounded by two major thoroughfares in the Makati central business district—Ayala and Senator Gil J. Puyat avenues.
