## Cone Room, 3/F

An adjunct to the **Y Space** is the Cone Room at the third floor with designers’ Tony Gonzales and Tes Pasola’s iconic *Suspended Garden* — an installation of paper rocks, reminiscent of a floating Japanese garden — as centerpiece. The Cone Room’s acoustics are ideal for music functions.
